

### **Safety Tips**

- Obey all traffic laws. Drive defensively, assuming that others do not see you. Use approved hand signals for turning and stopping.
- Always keep the front and rear lights on while riding after sunset.
- Always wear a helmet.
- Always wear shoes that are stable on your feet and offer good traction with the pedal.
   Do not drive barefoot or wearing sandals.
- Do not ride with headphones. They cover the traffic sounds and prevent you from concentrating on proper driving. The wiring can also be entangled in the moving parts of the bicycle, causing you to lose control.
- Remember that you are sharing the road with other cyclists and pedestrians.

#### **Terms and Conditions of Rental Agreement**

#### Driver's age

The minimum age is 18 years. Due to regulations, no bikes will be offered to children under 18 not accompanied by a parent or guardian.

#### Restrictions

- The passengers under no circumstances should exceed the maximum number of passengers as defined by the manufacturer and the company.
- The lessee is obliged to use the vehicle properly, conforming to the public safety rules and the laws governing safe driving.
- The lessee declares that he/she will not proceed with the rental and use of vehicles under the influence of alcohol or other substances.
- The company has the right to refuse to rent any bicycle to people who are drunk or under the influence of drugs and / or stimulants.
- The company will under no circumstances be liable for any accidents and/or damage to the passengers or third parties caused by the improper behavior or driving of the driver and passengers, as well as criminal mischief during the rental. Solely responsible/liable for all above mentioned is the user/driver/renter.
- The lessee declares that before each rental, inspects the bicycle and the functionality of it, and concludes that it is of irrevocable acceptance and is picked up in excellent manufacturing condition and functionality. The lessee, under no circumstances proceeds with a rental, if there is a fault on the leased bike. Picking up a bike for rental, constitutes the aforementioned declaration acceptance of the above.
- The use of protective equipment and helmet during every rental/lease was instructed during the registration. The
  use of helmet and protective equipment is provided freely and is unhindered.
- The car base is obligatory to carry a hazard triangle
- In case of loss of the bicycle, the lessor company has the right to charge the existing credit / debit card in the amount of 720 euro.
- The tenant is responsible for the proper use of the bicycle base in case of any damage to the car, the proportional charge will be applied.

Regardless of the above, the store is entitled to prohibit the entry and rental of any person it deems, without being obliged to justify this decision.

Useful tips for proper use of the bicycle

- Your bike is made from natural wood ash America.
- Timber comes from controlled logging forests and cutting is based on international standards.
- Wood is a hygroscopic material (throughout the lifetime does not stop to absorb and expel moisture).
- Natural varnishes and oils are unable to stop this process.
- Moisture in a closed environment and the continuous contact of wood with the soil creates conditions for fungal growth as well as discoloration of wood or cyanosis.
- $\bullet$  Do not park the bicycle next to hotplates and in high temperature environments.
